



Schedule of Fees 2026-27

The below table outlines our **standard schedule of fees** for a variety of service types.

Occupational therapy <i>initial parent consultation</i> (90 minutes) incorporating initial interview and history gathering, goal setting, and establishing baseline function to provide a benchmark for future assessment and reviews. For children, the first consultation is conducted with parent/carer alone to ensure it is possible to gather a detailed history and understanding of current function	1.5 hours @ \$193.99 per hour = \$290.99
Occupational therapy standard therapy consultation – 1.25 hours (60-minutes direct therapy including set-up, pack-up, transitions in and out, and carer feedback, 15-minutes non-face-to-face pre-session research/planning/resource development and post-session clinical documentation/follow-up)	1.25 hours @ \$193.99 per hour = \$242.49
Occupational therapy assistant standard therapy consultation – 1.25 hours (60-minutes direct therapy including set-up, pack-up, transitions in and out, and carer feedback, 15-minutes non-face-to-face pre-session research/planning/resource development and post-session clinical documentation/follow-up) Registered occupational therapist programming, supervision, review and liaison (non-face-to-face therapy services) – 20 minutes	1.25 hours @ \$86.79 per hour = \$108.49 \$64.66 per session Total: \$173.15
Occupational therapy <i>comprehensive functional capacity assessment</i> for NDIS purposes. This includes: - initial interview, history gathering, goal setting, - establishing baseline function to provide a benchmark for future assessment and outcome measurement, - review and summary of previous relevant reports, - determination and completion of necessary standardised assessments (e.g., WHODAS, PEDI-CAT, Vineland, Ages and Stages, Life Skills Profile, Carer Impact Scale, Sensory Profile, Executive Functioning Assessment), - preparation of comprehensive report, including background, function against NDIS domains, interpretation of standardised assessments and recommendations (typically 20-30 pages). - If major revisions are requested this time is billable. - Complexity and related fee to be discussed and agreed upon before commencement of report writing. Face to face consultation and half of expected non face to face (report) fee are to be paid before the report is completed. Remainder of report to be paid in full before report released.	Estimated 12-15 hours @ \$193.99 per hour, depending on complexity. This usually includes 3-4 hours face to face consultation and assessment, and 9-12 hours non face to face supports – standardised assessment interpretation and report writing.
Occupational therapy <i>brief functional assessment</i> to support NDIS access or for other purposes (e.g., school provisions, support unit application etc). This includes: - initial interview and history gathering, - goal setting, - establishing baseline function to provide a benchmark for future assessment and outcome measurement,	2.5 hours face to face consultation and assessment @ \$193.99 per hour = \$484.98 Face to face consultation fee

- review and summary of previous relevant reports, 1 NDIS preferred standardised assessment (e.g., WHODAS, PEDI-CAT, Vineland) - preparation of report, including background, function against NDIS domains, interpretation of standardised assessment and recommendations (typically 12-15 pages) Additional standardised assessments charged separately if required. Particularly complex reports may require additional time and would be discussed on a case-by-case basis. If major revisions are requested this time is billable.	and half of the expected non face to face (report) fee are to be paid before the report is completed. 5 hours non face to face supports – review and summary of previous reports, standardised assessment interpretation and report writing @193.99 per hour = \$969.95 Remainder of report to be paid for in full before the finalised report will be released. Total = \$1454.93
Occupational therapy <i>single</i> standardised assessment – online or paper-based data collection completed independently by client/carer, interpretation, and preparation of report including recommendations (for example one of: Sensory Profile; PEDI-CAT, D-REF Executive Function Assessment; Ages and Stages, Vineland; GARS). *If therapist is requested to support administration of the assessment face to face, this time is also billable as a standard consultation.	1.5 hours @ \$193.99 = \$290.99 *If a single assessment is administered to two raters across two environments (e.g. Sensory Profile home <i>and</i> school versions) this will be billed at 2.5 hours @ \$193.99 = \$484.98
Occupational therapy comprehensive fine motor/visual motor/gross motor assessment (e.g. BOT-2, M-FUN) including interpretation, reporting and recommendations.	2.5 hours face to face assessment @ \$193.99 per hour = \$484.98 2 hours non face to face supports – standardised assessment interpretation and report writing @193.99 per hour = \$387.98 Total: \$872.96
Annual progress review and report – necessary for all NDIS early childhood approach participants, and prior to Plan end-dates for NDIS participants (annual reports are highly recommended). *Should standardised assessments be required for inclusion in the progress report, these are charged separately.	1.25 hour face to face assessment/family consultation = \$242.49 2 hours non face to face supports – preparation of report and recommendations for next plan @ \$193.99 per hour = \$387.98 Total = \$630.47
Individualised resource development by registered OT (e.g. home program, visual schedule, social story etc)	\$193.99 per hour, billable in 10-minute increments

Individualised resource development by OT assistant	\$86.79 per hour, billable in 10-minute increments
Preparation of documentation, for example: - letter of support, for example to NDIS for low-cost, low-risk assistive technology - carer's allowance application - application for inclusion support funding or support unit - recommendation letter for school regarding reasonable adjustments - update report to paediatrician	\$193.99 per hour, billable in 10-minute increments – typically 1-2 hours depending on complexity and length of letter required.
Mid-cost assistive technology assessment/trial and report (e.g. specialised pram, car seat, vehicle harness)	\$193.99 per hour, billable in 10-minute increments – typically 1-3 hours for assessment/trial and 3-5 hours for report, depending on complexity.
Coordination of therapy visits to schools or preschools. This includes liaison regarding scheduling, mandatory training, inductions, completion of engagement documentation required by school or preschools, liaison with learning support teams and classroom teachers.	1 hour @ \$193.99 per hour per student per school year. Administration fees which some schools are now charging to grant school access to external therapists must also be covered by the participant.
Other services, including consultation face-to-face or via phone or email with other health professionals, educators, case managers, support coordinators, collaborative team meetings etc.	\$193.99 per hour, billable in 10-minute increments
Occupational therapist travel labour costs to deliver services in home, community, or place of education or work	\$97/h, for max of 30 mins in each direction – max charge \$97 travel time per visit.
Therapist travel non-labour costs (mileage/vehicle running costs)	\$1/km
Therapy assistant travel to deliver services in home, community, or place of education or work	\$43.39/hr, for max of 30 mins in each direction – max charge \$86.79 travel time per visit
Therapy assistant travel non-labour costs (mileage/vehicle running costs)	\$1/km
